

WELLINGTON HALL ACADEMY
2020-21 PLAN FOR IN-CLASS AND ONLINE LEARNING

August 1, 2020

On September 9, 2020, Wellington Hall will open for in-school learning, but students may opt to do full-time, at-home, synchronous online learning. This allows families who want to send their children to school to be able to do so, and it respects the concerns other families have about the public health situation. The table below lists the key elements of each option. Many more details are being worked out and will be provided in August.

IN-CLASS OPTION	ONLINE OPTION
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • students attend school as normal • daily screening for COVID-19 symptoms • many protocols for sickness and COVID exposure • students grouped into cohorts of no more than 16 people (including teachers) • cohorts move together throughout the day with no mingling with other cohorts (e.g. each cohort has its own lunch, recess, bathroom breaks, etc) • students distance within their cohorts as much as possible • desks will be spaced inside classrooms to ensure at least 6' distancing • staggered drop-off and pick-up times and controlled time in common spaces to eliminate interaction of cohorts • students in grade 1 and higher, and staff, will wear face coverings • extensive education, practice, and reminders on distancing, handwashing, cough & sneeze hygiene, and cleaning • rigorous cleaning schedules for all surfaces and materials • improved ventilation within the school • classes held outdoors when possible 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • students use Zoom to participate at the same time (synchronously) with the activities happening at school in their grade cohort • students will follow the same schedule as their cohort at school – learning at the same time, taking breaks and lunch at the same time, ending the day at the same time • students will interact with the teacher and other students • students will be included in school life as much as practical • attendance and participation expectations are the same as if the student were at school • an initial package of supplies and materials will be put together for each student at the beginning of the year • students must have a printer available at home • if field trips and special in-class activities occur, online students have the option of attending

Because we need to prepare the classrooms for distancing, we will need families to make a decision before **July 31 regarding their preferred option. The registration deadline for new students is **August 5**. After that date, students may be accepted if space remains in classes. Classes have a maximum of 15 students combined, in-class and online (12 students for kindergarten).**

The fee schedule for all options is attached. The fees reflect the fact that online learning requires the same, and often more, preparation time by teachers as in-class learning, has greater technology requirements, and that the school's overhead expenses do not change. However, online learning fees

are reduced to account for fewer supplies used and reduced participation in field trips and certain in-class activities (online students can choose to join these activities if distanced space is available, and would pay for each event separately).

This year will not be ideal for any of us. But we pledge to you that we will be doing our very best to recreate the positive family environment and great learning opportunities that WHA is known for, no matter the form our classes take. We already have some very fun learning units set up for this year that we are excited about. And we want to reduce anxiety among our young learners as much as possible as we establish new routines and explore emotions around these changes.

We can't wait to see everyone, in one form or another, in September. Please enjoy the rest of your summer break.
